Pursuant to RSA 21-I:54, authorize the Department of Health & Human Services, NHH – Facility/Patient Support, to continue one full-time temporary Financial Agent 1, Position #8T3091, salary grade 20 effective December 16, 2022 upon Governor and Council approval through December 15, 2023. 87.6% General Funds, 12.4% Other Funds.

EXPLANATION

The Financial Agent I, Position #8T3091, currently ends on December 15, 2022. This position is assigned to DHHS-NHH, Revenue Cycle Operations (Patient Financial Services). The position is currently vacant, however recruiting will commence soon to support the implementation of the IMD Waiver implementation, in which NHH seeks reimbursement for patients aged 21 on admission up to 64 years old.

The Financial Agent I position is a key position in researching and identifying patient benefit plans. The position researches patients' Medicaid, Managed Care, and/or Commercial Insurance plans and ensures they are still active plans. If a patient is uninsured, the position meets with patients, their families, and/or their guardian to research potential benefit plans and the patient's ability to pay. The position interacts with clinical staff as well as outside guarantors to ensure NHH maximizes reimbursement for patient care. The position also provides support to our Appeals/Denials Specialist should NHH appeal a guarantor's denial.
