REQUESTED ACTION

1. Authorize the Department of Transportation to enter into a contract with J.P. Sicard, Inc. (Vendor 227157) of Barton, VT, on the basis of a low bid of \$847,690 for bridge preservation response to stabilize two bridges in Dorchester and one in Lyme from scour (Project: Statewide Scour Response 41915A) from the date of Governor and Council approval through November 3, 2023, unless amended by the Department in accordance with the Standard Specifications. 100% Federal Funds.

Funding is available in State Fiscal Year 2023 and is anticipated to be available in Fiscal Year 2024 as follows, with the ability to adjust encumbrances through the Budget Office between State Fiscal Years if needed and justified:

2. Further authorize that a contingency in the amount of \$84,769.00 be approved for payment of latent conditions, which may appear during the construction of the project. The contingency requested is 10% of the contract amount.

EXPLANATION

This project is part of the State's Ten-Year Transportation Improvement Plan, under the Bridge-Tier 1-2 Maintenance Preservation, Bridge-Tier 3-4-Maintenance-Preservation Programs. This project is a bridge preservation response to stabilize the following bridges from scour:

- Dorchester Br. No. 138/064, NH 118 over Bucks Brook
- Dorchester Br. No. 155/088, River Road over South Branch Baker River
- Lyme Br. No. 075/106, NH 10 over Grant Brook

The purpose of this bridge preservation project is to stabilize the bridges listed above from scour. Bridge inspections have showed these bridges to have exposed footings, undermined wings, missing stone along the face of the wings, and scour holes.

The proposed contingency amount 10% of the contract amount. Excavation and rip-rap quantities were estimated from field observations. The nature of the channel may have changed since these observations were made. There is potential for quantity overruns of these items.

Although the bid costs exceeded the Department's estimate by 17.12%, the low bid of two bids received is felt to be reasonable for the work involved. Five items of significance accounted for 100% of the overage (crushed stone, access for bridge construction, water diversion structure (2), and mobilization). Re-advertising this project would result, in our opinion, in higher prices and prevent the completion of the work in a timely manner. The Department considers it to be in the best interest of the State to accept this bid to accomplish these needed repairs.


The Contractor has been prequalified by this Department. The Contract has been approved by the Attorney General as to form and execution, and the Department has certified that the necessary funds are available and the bid reasonably conforms to the engineer's estimate in accordance with State procedure. Copies of the fully executed contract are on file at the Secretary of State's Office and the Department of Administrative Service's Office, and subsequent to Governor and Council approval will be on file at the Department of Transportation.

This project funding is: 80% Federal (Bridge-Tier 1-2 - Maintenance-Preservation, Bridge-Tier 3-4 - Maintenance-Preservation), with anticipated utilization of Turnpike Toll Credits for the State's 20% match, effectively using 100% Federal Funds.

A copy of the Tabulation of Bids received for this project is attached along with the Contract Supplemental Sheet and a map indicating the location of the project.

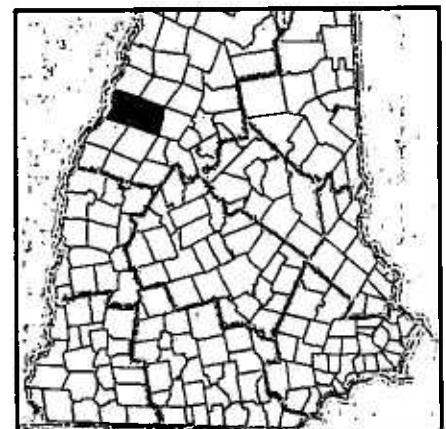
