REQUESTED ACTION

Authorize the Department of Safety (DOS), Division of State Police, to accept and expend \$92,869.00 from the Department of Safety, Office of Highway Safety, titled NHSP Distracted Driving Patrols for the purpose of encouraging all motor vehicle operators to focus on the task of driving. Effective upon Governor and Council approval through September 30, 2023. Funding Source: 100% Intra Agency Transfers

EXPLANATION

These federal pass-through funds are being used to hire, on an off-duty basis, currently employed State Police Troopers to conduct distracted driving patrols throughout the State, with a focus on high traffic count and crash locations. These patrols are conducted in an effort to encourage motorists to focus their full attention on driving safely and to refrain from using hand-held devices while driving. This is being done in conjunction with the use of statewide Electronic Message Board system (EMB's) and other media outlets to inform the motoring public that the law prohibiting the use of hand-held devices while driving is being strictly enforced.

Funds are to be budgeted as follows:

Funds in Class 18 are needed to pay the overtime for details as approved by the approving Federal Agency.

Funds in Class 40 are needed to pay the indirect cost on the remaining appropriations.

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December 2, 2022
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Funds in Class 60 are needed to pay for benefits associated with the overtime for the details as approved by the approving Federal Agency.

Although the Department included this grant in the SFY 2023 budget, the amount of the Federal grant received is higher than what was budgeted, therefore requiring the above requested action.

In the event that Agency Income funds become no longer available General and/or Highway funds will not be requested to support this program.


