REQUESTED ACTION

Pursuant to MOP 1301, VI, D, authorize the New Hampshire Fish and Game Department to allow the Waterfowl Project Leader, Jessica Carloni, to travel over 300 miles one way in a state vehicle to Lancaster, Pennsylvania to attend the Summer Meeting of the Atlantic Flyway Council, Technical Sections, and the Atlantic Coast Joint Venture Management Board from September 10 through September 15, 2023 upon Governor and Executive Council approval. Funding is 75% Federal, 25% Other (Game Management Account).

EXPLANATION

New Hampshire Fish and Game is requesting permission for one Department biologist to attend the Summer Meeting of the Atlantic Flyway Council, Technical Sections, and the Atlantic Coast Joint Venture Management Board held in Lancaster, Pennsylvania via state vehicle. This meeting is attended by waterfowl biologists across the Atlantic Flyway. While there, biologists and Federal partners from the USFWS discuss the status of waterfowl populations and the 2024-25 season setting packages of numerous waterfowl species. Recent waterfowl research projects are also shared and discussed. Given the increasing complexity of impacts to our natural world it is essential that our biological staff have access to the most recent research and management initiatives and be able to discuss the results and implications of both our own and other new initiatives with their peers.

We are requesting that staff be allowed to drive instead of flying, 432 miles each way. The total cost for flying, including staff time, would be \$1,774.71 versus \$1,069.47 for driving, resulting in a savings of \$705.24. Please see attached cost comparison spreadsheet, and meeting agenda.


