EXPLANATION

This course, *Analysis of Algorithms*, will benefit the Department and Melissa Mullen by helping to develop technical skills and knowledge that will allow the employee to better serve the residents of New Hampshire. *Analysis of Algorithms* focuses on methods for designing and analyzing efficient algorithms with an emphasis on methods used in practice, as well as practical implementation methods.

Melissa has been employed with the Department of Health and Human Services for 1.5 years and currently serves as a Sexually Transmitted Infection Statistical Assistant in the Bureau of Infectious Disease Control with the Division of Public Health. In this position, the employee is responsible for compiling sexually transmitted disease surveillance data, contacting healthcare providers and other state agencies to collect and verify case information, conducting statistical analyses, and preparing various statistical reports.

This education will directly impact Melissa's job performance at DHHS by improving the overall efficiency of the employee's work. It will help Melissa to conduct deeper analyses of sexually transmitted disease data in an effort to identify and reduce health disparities across the state and allocate resources to communities and individuals disproportionately affected by the social determinants of health. Completing this course is also part of Melissa's longer term goal of obtaining a Master's in Applied Data Analytics.

The Department of Health and Human Services encourages and supports employees who wish to further their professional growth through continuing education in disciplines that are mutually advantageous. Successful completion of the courses will add to the overall strength of the Department to perform its mission for the residents of New Hampshire.

This course will not be taken on State time.

THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE
EDUCATIONAL TUITION AGREEMENT

Agreement dated this 12th day of July 2023 by and through the Department of Health and Human Services (hereinafter referred to as the "State") and Melissa Mullen (hereinafter referred to as the "Recipient"). The State and the Recipient do hereby mutually agree as follows:

1. The State shall pay to the named institution the sum of \$2140.00, which monies shall be used for the purpose of enrolling the Recipient in: MET CS 566 Analysis of Algorithms, which course(s) is being offered by Boston University's Metropolitan College (MET) and which course(s) shall commence on 09/05 2023 and terminate on 10/23 2023.
2. The Recipient shall complete and achieve a passing grade in each course named in paragraph 1.
3. Should the Recipient fail to complete or achieve a passing grade in each course named in paragraph 1, the Recipient shall pay to the State the sum set forth in paragraph 1, provided, however, that if more than one course is named in paragraph 1, the amount which shall be paid to the State shall be calculated on a pro rata basis.
4. Upon the satisfactory completion of the courses named in paragraph 1, the Recipient shall continue in the employ of the State in his/her current position (or in such other position, at equal or greater compensation, to which he/she may be assigned) for a period of six (6) months.
5. The Recipient shall work in any area of the State to which he/she may be assigned, provided that such assignment will not constitute a severe hardship to said Recipient.
6. Should the Recipient breach any of the conditions set forth in paragraphs 4 and 5, the Recipient shall pay to the State a sum equal to all monies previously paid by the State for the Recipient pursuant to the Agreement, provided, however, that the Recipient shall receive a credit for each month in which he/she is employed by the State subsequent to the date upon which the named course(s) are satisfactorily completed, the value of said credit to be calculated on a pro rata basis.
7. The Recipient shall not raise any setoff or counterclaim against the State in any action brought by the State to collect any amount due under this agreement.
8. Should any amount be found to be due the State in any action brought against the Recipient pursuant to this Agreement, the State shall, in addition to said amount, be entitled to an award of costs and a reasonable amount in "attorney" fees.
