#### REQUESTED ACTION

Authorize the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health Services, to hold an organized meeting on August 31, 2023 at the Puritan Conference Center for a total State cost not to exceed \$5,000 for the purpose of training on Respect and Civility in the Workplace, effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval through June 30, 2024. 100% Federal Funds.

#### **EXPLANATION**

Each year the New Hampshire (NH) Women, Infants and Children (WIC) Directors Association hosts an annual WIC Forum. The full-day training is intended to provide educational opportunities, round table discussion and keynote speakers to support healthy and professional workplaces for the NH WIC Program and local WIC agencies.

Local WIC agencies are required to train their staff about Respect and Civility in the Workplace. This ensures a safe, respectful and thriving work environment for the staff that serve the families enrolled in the NH WIC Nutrition Program. The Department of Administrative Services, Bureau of Education and Training will provide an interactive 90 minute training for 80 attendees on August 31, 2023 at the Puritan Conference Center in Manchester, NH. The sole speaker for the Respect and Civility in the Workplace will be Stephen Mason, an employee of the Department of Administrative Services. This is an allowable cost under the WIC Nutrition Program, 100% funded by the United States Department of Agriculture, to support staff training and development.
