Authorize the Department of Agriculture, Markets and Food, Regulatory Services to **Retroactively** make a one-time unencumbered payment in the amount of \$15,970 to the United States Department of Agriculture, National Agricultural Statistics Service (USDA-NASS) (Vendor #177817), Harrisburg, PA for conducting a survey of New Hampshire growers, effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval. 100% Revolving Funds

EXPLANATION

This request is for a **Retroactive**, unencumbered payment for a cooperative project for conducting surveys on vegetable growers, berry growers, tree fruit growers, and grape growers.
