### REQUESTED ACTION

- Pursuant to RSA 14:30-a, VI, authorize the Department of Business and Economic Affairs, Division of Economic Development, Office of International Commerce (OIC) to retroactively amend Fiscal item #FIS 21-328, originally approved by the Fiscal Committee on November 19, 2021, and by the Governor and Council on November 22, 2021, Item #62, by extending the end date from June 30, 2023, to June 30, 2025 for grant funds from the U.S. Department of Commerce, International Trade Administration's Market Development Cooperator Program (MDCP) grant program (Award# IT21INA1120005), effective upon Fiscal Committee and Governor and Executive Council approval. 100% Federal Funds.
- 2. Contingent upon the approval of Requested Action #1, authorize the Department of Business and Economic Affairs, Division of Economic Development, Office of International Commerce (OIC) to accept and expend grant funds from the U.S. Department of Commerce, International Trade Administration's Market Development Cooperator Program (MDCP) grant program (Award# IT21INA1120005) in the amount of \$65,852, effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval through June 30, 2025. 100% Federal Funds.

### **EXPLANATION**

This request is **retroactive** as the beginning date of July 1, 2023, associated with this request is in the new biennium. It is the policy of the Fiscal Committee of the General Court to act only on items within the current biennium and this is the first Fiscal Committee meeting in the new biennium.

Approval of this request will allow OIC to continue to use funds awarded through the U.S. Department of Commerce, International Trade Administration's Market Development Cooperator Program (MDCP) to support efforts by New Hampshire businesses to expand their ability to sell online to customers around the world.

Authorized by Congress in 1988, MDCP is a cooperative effort that includes awards to assist in new foreign market development projects. The aim of MDCP projects is to promote the expansion of exports of nonagricultural goods and services produced in the United States. MDCP projects include a financial assistance component as well as access to the domestic and international network of International Trade Administration staff to leverage opportunities internationally.

The MDCP funding has helped establish a New Hampshire eGlobal Institute, building on the efforts that OIC started with its Go eGlobal program. This Institute provides access to New Hampshire companies to business counselling from OIC and public and private sector partners throughout the state about the importance of having a digital strategy. The Institute also provides educational and other resources for companies to implement digital strategies to sell to consumers around the world.

The total grant amount awarded to OIC was \$181,034, through September 30, 2026.

Funds are budgeted as follows:

- Class 041 Audit Fund Set-Aside to comply with RSA 124:16 which requires all agencies which receive federal funds set aside a percentage (0.1%) of federal revenue amount received to pay for financial and compliance audits.
- Class 102 Contracts for Program Services contract to pay for the establishing and marketing the program, hosting educational assets for New Hampshire companies to access and incorporate digital capacity and digital strategy in making international sales.

Indirect costs are not included in this proposal; this grant only allows for direct costs.

In the event Federal Funds are no longer available, General Funds will not be requested to continue the support of this program.

### **EXPLANATION**

Authorized by Congress in 1988, the U.S. Department of Commerce, International Trade Administration's Market Development Cooperator Program (MDCP) is a cooperative effort that includes awards to assist in new foreign market development projects. The aim of MDCP projects is to promote the expansion of exports of nonagricultural goods and services produced in the United States. MDCP projects include a financial assistance component as well as access to the domestic and international network of International Trade Administration staff to leverage opportunities internationally.

This is first time that the State of New Hampshire has received an MDCP award. OIC will use the funding to establish a program designed to increase the digital capacity of New Hampshire-based companies that are looking to begin exporting or to expand their presence in foreign markets.

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With the COVID-19 pandemic demonstrating the importance of having a virtual presence, being competitive in the digital marketplace has never been more important for business. Today, companies must be tech savvy, with a virtual presence built around a digital strategy that incorporates all facets of marketing, from online discovery through search engine optimization, to connecting with the right customer though localization efforts.

The MDCP funding will be used to establish a New Hampshire eGlobal Institute, building on the efforts that OIC started with its Go eGlobal program. The funding will be used for New Hampshire companies to get access to business counselling from OIC and public and private sector partners throughout the state, about the importance of having a digital strategy to do business internationally and the components important to keep in the forefront.

The total grant amount awarded to OIC is \$181,034.00, to run over a period of five years (ending on September 30, 2026). At this time, OIC is only requesting to accept and expend \$115,182.00, which is the portion of the grant award expected to be expended by the end of fiscal year 2023.

Funds are budgeted as follows:

Class 041 – Audit Fund Set-Aside – payment of audit fee set aside associated with federal funding to comply with RSA 124:16 that requires all agencies which receive federal funds to set aside a percentage (0.1%) of the federal revenue amount received to pay for financial and compliance audits. The total revenue award for a period of five years is \$181,034.00.

Class 102 – Contracts for Program Services – contract to pay for the establishing and marketing the program, hosting educational assets for New Hampshire companies to access and incorporate digital capacity and digital strategy in making international sales.

Indirect costs are not included in this proposal: this grant only allows for direct costs.

In the event that Federal Funds are no longer available, General Funds will not be requested to continue the support of this program.
