## EXPLANATION

This request is retroactive as the beginning date of July 1,2023 , associated with this request is in the new biennium. It is the policy of the Fiscal Committee of the General Court to act only on items within the current biennium and this is the first Fiscal Committee meeting in the new biennium.

Approval of this request will allow the Office of International Commerce to continue to use funds awarded to support small business export promotion programs funded by the U.S. Small Business Administration's State Trade Expansion Program (STEP) grant program, Round 10.

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STEP, which was created under the Small Business Jobs Act of 2010, awards financial assistance grants to states for the purpose of furthering their efforts of assisting small businesses in preparing for new international markets, complying with trade regulations, accessing export financing, and participating in international trade shows and trade missions. These grants allow for the creation of specialized programs to focus on international markets with the highest growth potential and to engage industries with the greatest and most immediate ability to compete successfully.

The State of New Hampshire has successfully been awarded STEP funds in nine previous rounds of this competitive grant, making the current cycle the tenth round of funding. New Hampshire is one of fifty-two states and territories to receive a STEP grant award this year.

The total grant amount awarded to the Department of Business and Economic Affairs (BEA) for STEP, Round 10, is $\$ 250,000$, to run through September 29, 2024.

Funds are budgeted as follows:
Class 040 - Indirect Costs - all agencies receiving outside funding from any source are required by RSA 21-1:75 to recover a proportional share of the outside funding source to alleviate agency indirect costs.

Class 041 - Audit Fund Set-Aside - to comply with RSA 124:16 that requires all agencies which receive federal funds to set aside a percentage (0.1\%) of the federal revenue amount received to pay for financial and compliance audits.

Class 080 - Out of State Travel Reimbursement - funding for BEA staff to travel to London, UK, to support New Hampshire businesses participating in the Defence and Security Equipment International (DSEI) trade show in September 2023.

Class 102 - Contracts for Program Services - contracts for financial management of direct financial assistance awards to businesses and for organizing and facilitating New Hampshire's participation at the DSEI trade show in September 2023.

In the event Federal Funds are no longer available, General Funds will not be requested to continue the support of this program.

The State of New Hampshire has successfully been awarded STEP funds in nine previous rounds of this competitive grant, making the current cycle the tenth round of funding. Now Hampshire is one of fifty-two states and teritories to receive a STEP grant award this year.

In one of the most recently concluded rounds of funding (STEP 8), New Hampshire was awarded $\$ 241,233$ in federal funding, which was used to support fifty-wwo New Hampshire businesses with education and training on exporting processes as well as in finding and entering new markets. Based on feedback from those participating Now Hampshire businesses, this funding resulted in more than $\$ 15.8$ milllon in exports and 483 jobs created or retained during the grant period.

The total grant amount awarded to the Department of Business and Economic Affairs (BEA) is $\$ \mathbf{2 5 0 , 0 0 0}$, to run over a period of two years (ending on September 29, 2024).

BEA plans to award a contract vla a compettive process for assistance with faciftating direct financial assistance awards to New Hampshire businesses and for organizing and facilitating trade show participation by BEA staff and by New Hampshire businesses at the defense- and security-themed DSEI trade show in London, UK, in 2023. Sufficient funding is provided by the grant to invite 5-6 New. Hampshire businesses with interest in these industries in the UK and throughout Europe to help foster business opportunities in this important sector.

BEA will aiso use.travel funding under this grant to fund one staff person's travel to the DSEI trade show to support the participating New Hampshire businesses.

Funds are budgeted as follows:
Class 040 - Indirect Costs - BEA will withdraw funds at the rate of $6.6 \%$ of direct costs.
Class 080 - Out of 'State Travel Reimbursement - funding for BEA staff to traved to a trade show out of the country.

Class 102 - Contracts for Program Services - contracts for the above mentioned services.
