REQUESTED ACTION

Authorize the Department of Environmental Services to amend a Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) loan agreement (PO #9005774) with the City of Claremont (VC #177373 B001) to increase funding by \$700,000, from \$3,469,000 to \$4,169,000, under the provisions of RSA 486:14 and N.H. Code of Admin. Rules Env-Wq 500 et seq., effective upon Governor & Council approval. The original loan agreement was approved by Governor & Council on January 12, 2022, as Item No. 65. Funding is 100% CWSRF Repayment Funds.

Funding is available in the account as follows:

EXPLANATION

The purpose of this Amendment is to increase the City of Claremont CWSRF Loan by \$700,000 to fund increases in costs due to inflation of unit prices of materials and labor, and the scarcity of electrical components. In addition, continued supply chain issues have prolonged the project schedule and delayed the availability of numerous critical electrical components. To date \$299,703 of the existing loan has been disbursed.

The Supplemental (final) loan amount will be based upon the total CWSRF funds disbursed and may be less than \$4,169,000. Under federal capitalization grant requirements, this loan includes principal forgiveness of up to \$416,900. Currently, there is \$67,893,890 available to loan after this request.

To increase the City of Claremont's loan amount for the WWTF Electrical Upgrades Project, CWSRF Loan Number CS-330114-21, by \$700,000, from \$3,469,000 to \$4,169,000.

Now therefore, amend the ORIGINAL LOAN AGREEMENT, as approved by Governor and Council on January 12, 2022 as Item No. 65 in the following manner:

Change only Page 1 lines 15 through 16 of the ORIGINAL LOAN AGREEMENT to read as follows:

"...State, in accordance with the terms of this Agreement, the principal sum of Four Million, One Hundred Sixty-Nine Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$4,169,000) (Principal Sum) or such lesser...";

And, change only Page 1, lines 20 through 21 of the ORIGINAL LOAN AGREEMENT to read as follows:

"...the initial repayment as follows: A portion of the principal sum, not to exceed Four Hundred Sixteen Thousand, Nine Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$416,900) or 10% of the total of ...";

And, change only Page 3, line 5 of the ORIGINAL LOAN AGREEMENT to read as follows:

"...date is hereby determined to be August 2, 2025; however, should the project experience an...".

EXPLANATION

The purpose of the requested action is to authorize the City of Claremont to borrow up to \$3,469,000 from the CWSRF to finance the WWTF Electrical Upgrades project. The project will include updates to a variety of electrical components in the operations, headworks and administrative buildings, as well as the primary and secondary clarifiers, gravity thickeners, compost facility, standby power staging, hardwire interlocks, timer panels and control stations.

The Supplemental (final) loan amount will be based upon the total CWSRF funds disbursed, and may be less than \$3,469,000. Under federal capitalization grant requirements, this loan includes principal forgiveness of up to \$346,900.

Attached is a tabulation of the CWSRF showing the effect of this action on the funds available for loans.

The original loan agreement was approved by Governor & Council on September 18, 2019, as Item No. 71 and Amendment No. 1 was approved by the DES Commissioner on December 4, 2019. Funding is 100% CWSRF Repayment Funds.

EXPLANATION

The purpose of this Amendment is to increase the City of Portsmouth's existing CWSRF Loan by \$2,100,000 to fund conventional gravity sewers and low-pressure sewers along Sagamore Avenue and Walker's Bungalow Road. To date \$3,802,669.16 of the existing loan has been disbursed.

The Supplemental (final) loan amount will be based upon the total CWSRF funds disbursed and may be less than \$6,500,000. Under federal capitalization grant requirements, this loan includes principal forgiveness of up to \$975,000. Currently, there is \$68,573,890 available to loan after this request.
