REQUESTED ACTION

Authorize the Department of Environmental Services to amend a Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) loan agreement with the City of Portsmouth (VC #177463 B001) to increase funding by \$2,100,000, from \$4,400,000 to \$6,500,000, under the provisions of RSA 486:14 and N.H. Code of Admin. Rules Env-Wq 500 et seq., effective upon Governor & Council approval. The original loan agreement was approved by Governor & Council on September 18, 2019, as Item No. 71 and Amendment No. 1 was approved by the DES Commissioner on December 4, 2019. Funding is 100% CWSRF Repayment Funds.

EXPLANATION

The purpose of this Amendment is to increase the City of Portsmouth's existing CWSRF Loan by \$2,100,000 to fund conventional gravity sewers and low-pressure sewers along Sagamore Avenue and Walker's Bungalow Road. To date \$3,802,669.16 of the existing loan has been disbursed.

The Supplemental (final) loan amount will be based upon the total CWSRF funds disbursed and may be less than \$6,500,000. Under federal capitalization grant requirements, this loan includes principal forgiveness of up to \$975,000. Currently, there is \$68,573,890 available to loan after this request.

AMENDMENT No. 2

TO STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE WATER POLLUTION CONTROL REVOLVING FUND PROGRAM CITY OF PORTSMOUTH, NEW HAMPSHIRE

ORIGINAL LOAN AGREEMENT

For Project CS-330106-17

To increase the City of Portsmouth's loan amount for the Sagamore Avenue Sewer Extension Project, CWSRF Loan Number CS-330106-17, by \$2,100,000, from \$4,400,000 to \$6,500,000.

Now therefore, amend the ORIGINAL LOAN AGREEMENT, as approved by Governor and Council on September 18, 2019, as Item No. 71 and amended on December 4, 2019, in the following manner:

Change only Page 1 lines 16 through 17 of the ORIGINAL LOAN AGREEMENT to read as follows:

"...State, in accordance with the terms of this Agreement, the principal sum of Six Million, Five Hundred Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$6,500,000) (Principal Sum) or such lesser amount as ...";

And, change only Page 1, lines 21 through 22 of the ORIGINAL LOAN AGREEMENT to read as follows:

"...the initial repayment as follows: A portion of the principal sum, not to exceed Nine Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$975,000) or 15% of the total of Disbursements,...";



REQUESTED ACTION

Authorize the Department of Environmental Services to approve a Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) loan agreement with the City of Portsmouth (VC #177463 B001) in an amount not to exceed \$4,400,000 to finance the Sagamore Avenue Sewer Extension Project under the provisions of RSA 486:14 and N.H. Code of Admin. Rules Env-Wq 500 et seq., effective upon Governor & Council approval. Funding is 83% Federal Funds, 17% Capital (Other) Funds.

Funds to support this request are anticipated to be available in the following account in FY 2020 upon the availability and continued appropriation of funds in the future operating budget.

EXPLANATION

The purpose of the requested action is to authorize the City of Portsmouth to borrow up to \$4,400,000 from the CWSRF to finance the Sagamore Avenue Sewer Extension Project. The project will serve approximately 97 residences and businesses with a new sewer system.

The Supplemental (final) loan amount will be based upon the total CWSRF funds disbursed, and may be less than \$4,400,000. Under federal capitalization grant requirements, this loan includes principal forgiveness of up to \$660,000.

Attached is a tabulation of the CWSRF showing the effect of this action on the funds available for loans.
