## REQUESTED ACTION

1. Authorize the Department of Transportation to enter into a contract with Pine Ridge Technologies, Inc. (Vendor 286308) of No. Reading, MA, on the basis of a low bid of \$178,076 for signal work at multiple locations Statewide (Project: Statewide Signals #44182), from the date of Governor and Council approval through September 27, 2024, unless amended by the Department in accordance with the Standard Specifications. 100% Other Funds.

Funding is available in State Fiscal Years 2024 and 2025 as follows, with the ability to adjust encumbrances through the Budget Office between State Fiscal Years if needed and justified:

2. Further authorize that a contingency in the amount of \$8,903.80 be approved for payment of latent conditions, which may appear during the construction of the project. The contingency requested is 5% of the contract amount.

#### **EXPLANATION**

This project is part of the State's Ten-Year Transportation Improvement Plan under the Betterment and Turnpike R&R programs. This project consists of signal work at multiple locations statewide:

- 44182 Replacement of signal meters and pedestals to include foundations.
- 43881 Replacement of traffic signal pole and mast arm for the signal S-119-01 on the NH 28 By-Pass at NH 28 and Island Pond Rd in Derry
- 44151 Replacement of the traffic signal pole, mast arm, and foundation for the signal S-315-14 on NH 111 at FEET Exit 5 SB Off Ramp in Nashua.

Update signal meter pedestals and foundations and replace signal mast arms damaged by collisions.

The proposed contingency amount is 5% of the contract amount. This is to account for the risks associated with unanticipated traffic control needs, the potential for necessary but unanticipated repair work to traffic signal-related equipment and other existing infrastructure near the work areas, and latent conditions encountered during excavation.

The Contractor has been prequalified by this Department. The Contract has been approved by the Attorney General as to form and execution, and the Department has certified that the necessary funds are available and the bid reasonably conforms to the engineer's estimate in accordance with State procedure. Copies of the fully executed contract are on file at the Secretary of State's Office and the Department of Administrative Service's Office, and subsequent to Governor and Council approval will be on file at the Department of Transportation.

This project funding is: 0% Federal funds (3031 Crash Reimbursement, 3039 Betterment, 7025 Turnpike R&R).

A copy of the Tabulation of Bids received for this project is attached along with the Contract Supplemental Sheet and a map indicating the location of the project.


