

REQUESTED ACTION

- 1. In accordance with RSA 94:3 (Yearly Service Increases), we respectfully request approval of an annual salary step increase for Meagan Rose, position (#9U374), Executive Assistant in the Executive Council Office, from Labor Grade AA, Step 3 (Salary \$70,557) to Labor Grade AA, Step 6 (Salary \$82,740) retroactive to October 5, 2023, effective upon Governor approval. 100% General Funds.
- 2. Contingent upon approval of requested action #1, authorize the payment of retroactive pay and benefits in the amount of \$15,694.71, effective upon Governor approval. 100% General Funds.

EXPLANATION

Meagan Rose was originally appointed to the position of Executive Assistant in the Office of the Executive Council effective October 5, 2018, and is eligible for a yearly service increase as described in RSA 94:3. Due to oversight, when eligible for step increases 4, 5, and 6 annually over the last few years, these step increase request actions were not pursued. Approval of this item will place Meagan at step 6 for which she is currently eligible.

The calculated retroactive pay and associated employer FICA and Medicare tax amounts owed for step increase from 3 to 4 eligible on October 5, 2021, step increase from 4 to 5 eligible on October 5, 2022, and step increase from 5 to 6 eligible on October 5, 2023, is \$15,694.71. Approval of this request will make Meagan whole for the step increases she was eligible for and did not pursue at the time.
