#### REQUESTED ACTION

Authorize the Department of Natural and Cultural Resources, Division of Forests and Lands to enter a contract with Martin Forestry Consulting, LLC, (VC# 228721) New Hampton, NH in the amount of \$14,000 to complete mechanical thinning of 10 acres of white pine saplings at Bear Brook State Park effective upon Governor and Council approval through April 1, 2024. 100% Federal Funds.

Funding is available in account, Forest Health – Federal, as follows:

#### **EXPLANATION**

This contract allows the Division of Forests and Lands, Forest Health Program to perform pre-commercial thinning of over 10 acres of dense white pine saplings and remove 90% of the tree competition. The results will improve tree health for the remaining crop trees and allow for faster growth and higher quality sawlogs during the next timber harvest.

On September 1, 2023, an invitation to submit bids for the low-density pine thinning project was issued in accordance with the Department of Administrative Services policy. The bid solicitation was posted on the Division of Purchase and Property's website. Three companies made inquiries during the bid process. All three visited the site with the project manager and all submitted bids prior to closing date on September 22, 2023. Martin Forestry Consulting was the lowest bidder.

The Attorney General's Office has reviewed and approved this contract as to form, substance, and execution.

#### Scope of Work

The purpose of this Contract is for the Contractor to provide to the State, the mechanical thinning of two five-acre blocks of white pine regeneration.

- a) The cutting of all unmarked pine will be accomplished with a tracked excavator and shear head not to exceed 16,000 pounds.
- b) trees to retain are marked in orange paint
- c) trees cut will be left on site and crushed or cut to lay less than four feet tall
- d) Marked trees that receive mechanical damage will be substituted with a suitable replacement
- e) Block 1, off Blackhall Road should be done before Block 2
